- Program:** **Summer Youth Employment Program** (Option 2: Age 16-24)
--funded & administered by the Department of Youth and Community Development (DYCD)

-- Attend virtual classes & workshops this summer, gain valuable work readiness skills, explore career options, and earn a stipend up to \$1,000 for the duration of the program.
- When/Where/How:**
- Five weeks starting on **July 27, 2020** and ends on **August 28, 2020**
 - Online via virtual platform (s)
 - Attend 18 hours' virtual classes & workshops per week
 - Learn about civic engagement, community services, life and leadership skills, labor market information, workplace culture, career exploration, work readiness, and more
 - Earn stipends up to \$200 per week for full attendance
- Who is eligible:** NYC youth ages 16-24 are eligible to apply; selection into SYEP is based on a lottery that starts on July 16, 2020.
- How to apply:** Youth may choose **Chinatown Manpower Project** as the **Provider** and submit an online application at <https://application.nycsyep.com>.

--If you submitted an online application in March and April 2020, you just need to confirm your interest in the new SYEP Bridge Program and your choice of Provider.
